

COLUCCI APPOINTED TO NBCE BOARD

Greeley, Colo.— Margaret R. Colucci, D.C., of Las Vegas, Nevada, was appointed by the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards (FCLB) to a one-year term on the board of the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners (NBCE).
