**DR. NORMAN OUZTS SELECTED AS NBCE'S NEW  
EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT**

**GREELEY, Colo.**—NBCE President Dr. Paul Morin announced today that Dr. Norman Ouzts, Jr., of Greenwood, South Carolina, has been selected to fill the role of NBCE Executive Vice President. Dr. Ouzts has served on the NBCE Board of Directors since 2007. He will resign his board position immediately.

Dr. Morin commented that “Dr. Ouzts brings 10 years of knowledge and involvement in the strategic objectives of the NBCE as well as the added benefit of experience in working with the NBCE board. His selection ensures there will be a smooth transition, positioning both the organization and Dr. Ouzts in a position for success.”

In accepting his new position, Dr. Ouzts assured the NBCE that “I will use my experience in communicating the board’s directives to the leadership team, and in a reciprocal fashion, I will champion the communication of project-driven initiatives currently underway at the NBCE to the board of directors.”

Dr. Ouzts has served in several capacities during his time on the NBCE Board of Directors: as Vice President from 2010-2012 and as President from 2012-2014, and as District V Director from 2007-2017.

In May 2016, the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards (FCLB) presented Dr. Ouzts with the George Arvidson Award for Meritorious Service to Chiropractic Regulation. He formerly served as District V Director of the FCLB.

Dr. Ouzts is a graduate of Life University in Atlanta, Georgia. He has been in practice in Greenwood since 1992. During his three terms of service on the South Carolina Board of Chiropractic Examiners, he served as Vice Chair from 2002 to 2004 and as Chair from 2004 to 2006.

Dr. Ouzts has also been a member of the South Carolina Chiropractic Association Board of Directors, serving as President from 2005 to 2006. That association awarded him a Distinguished Service Award in 2003, a Presidential Pillar of Strength Award in 2005, and named him Chiropractor of the Year in 2006. Also in 2006, Dr. Ouzts was recognized by the South Carolina Senate for his service to the chiropractic profession.

Headquartered in Greeley, Colo., the NBCE is the international testing organization for the chiropractic profession, with the mission of ensuring professional competency through excellence in testing. Established in 1963, the NBCE develops, administers and scores legally defensible, standardized written and practical examinations for candidates seeking chiropractic licensure throughout the United States and in several foreign countries.
