

NBCE Announces Policy Change

The NBCE is pleased to announce a change in policy that gives examinees more flexibility in scheduling their exams.

Examinees who cannot test at the time or location they have scheduled now have two options:

1. They can request a change of test sites. (This option is available for the Part I, II, III, and Physiotherapy exams only.)
2. They can transfer their registration to a different administration.

The NBCE Board of Directors realized that this policy was necessary to accommodate increased opportunities to take the Parts I, II, III, and Physiotherapy exams. The NBCE offers those exams five times in 2017, for example.

“When examinees could take their exams only in March or September, they planned their whole year around their board exams,” explained NBCE President Dr. Paul Morin. “Now, we recognize that conflicts can occur and want to allow our examinees the opportunity to reschedule and not delay their path toward licensure. We are happy to allow examinees other options besides withdrawing from their exams and reapplying at a later date.”

Examinees who wish to request these changes should submit a [change request form](#) and include applicable administrative fees. The NBCE plans to have this process available online before the applications open for the June 2017 exams.
