

# PRACTITIONER DEMOGRAPHICS

(Survey Pages 1 and 2)

In the **DEMOGRAPHIC DATA** section of the Survey of Chiropractic Practice, participants were asked to provide personal data by indicating **gender, ethnic origin, highest level of non-chiropractic education attained, specialty certification, and institution granting the doctor of chiropractic degree.**

Approximately 82% of the respondents reported that their practices are full-time. The average number of hours devoted to practice is 37.5 weekly.

Data obtained from these full-time respondents revealed that a majority of respondents are white males who have attained a baccalaureate degree or beyond, and who have been in practice for an entire career spanning 5-15 years. Approximately one-quarter of those surveyed nationwide possessed some form of post-graduate specialty board eligibility or certification.

Of the 37.5 hours a week devoted to chiropractic practice, the majority of time involves direct patient care, and the remaining time is equally divided between business management and patient education.

The following pages show a breakdown of the response data **by percent** on a state-by-state basis. Post-graduate specialty board eligibility or certification is presented on pages 4 and 5. Totals in this section exceed 100% because some practitioners reported eligibility in more than one specialty.

# PRACTITIONER WORK ENVIRONMENT (Survey Page 3)

In the **WORK ENVIRONMENT** section of the Survey of Chiropractic Practice, participants were asked to provide personal data describing the location of their office(s), and their mode of delivery of care.

On a national basis, approximately two-thirds of those participating in the survey indicated that they currently practice in a setting in which they are the only doctor in the office. The remainder indicated that there are two or more doctors in the office in which they practice.

Just over half of those surveyed indicated that they delegate certain patient care to a chiropractic assistant, and well over half indicated that they occasionally deliver chiropractic care outside the office setting.

Approximately 5% of the survey respondents nationwide indicated that they have staff privileges at a medical or osteopathic hospital; moreover, 77% reported that they had received referrals from medical or osteopathic physicians within the previous two years.
