



2016 NBCE Bylaws: Candidate Qualifications

Section 3. District Directors.

a) Composition. Five (5) Directors of the National Board shall be elected by the Delegates. There shall be one Director from each of the following Districts:

DISTRICT NO. 1 - Alaska, Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Washington and Wyoming.

DISTRICT NO. 2 - Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kentucky, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Ohio and Wisconsin.

DISTRICT NO. 3. - Connecticut, Delaware, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont and Washington D.C.

DISTRICT NO. 4 - Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Kansas, Nevada, New Mexico, Oklahoma, Texas and Utah.

DISTRICT NO. 5 - Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, Puerto Rico, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia and West Virginia.

b) Eligibility. In order to be eligible for initial election as a District Director of the National Board from one of the five (5) Districts, a nominee shall be a resident of said District whose Agency recognizes the successful completion of any part of the National Board examinations as a prerequisite to licensure and shall be a doctor of chiropractic who is a member and who represents said Agency or shall have been a member of such within a period of three (3) years prior to his or her nomination and election. In order to be eligible for election to additional consecutive terms as a District Director from one of the five (5) Districts at any election subsequent to his or her initial election, a nominee must meet the requirements in the preceding sentence but shall not be required to have been a representative of his or her Agency at the time of such subsequent election or within the three (3) - year period prior to such subsequent election.
