SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF ANNUAL MEETING OF DELEGATE ASSEMBLY

This Supplemental Notice supplements prior notices regarding the Annual Meeting of the Delegates (the “Meeting”) of the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners (the “NBCE”) to be held on Friday, May 1, 2026.

As previously communicated through a Special Update posted on October 20, 2025, at the Fall 2025 District meetings, and during subsequent Town Hall meetings held on December 18, 2025, January 29, February 19, March 19, and April 14, 2026, the NBCE has been engaged in discussions with the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards (the “FCLB”) regarding a combination of the NBCE and the FCLB in a single organization (the “Strategic Combination”).

The purpose of this Supplemental Notice is to notify the NBCE delegate representatives (the “Delegates”) that the Board of Directors of the NBCE unanimously approved the Strategic Combination, and one of the purposes of the Meeting is to present the Strategic Combination to the Delegates for ratification, including the following actions:

- the acquisition by NBCE of all, or substantially all, of the assets of the FCLB; and
- the amendment of the NBCE Bylaws in connection with the Strategic Combination.

**ACTIONS PRESENTED TO THE DELEGATES OF THE
NATIONAL BOARD OF CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINERS FOR RATIFICATION**

The following actions, which have been approved by the Board of Directors (the “Board”) of the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners, a nonprofit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Texas (the “NBCE”), are presented by the Board to the Delegates of the NBCE for ratification by the Delegates at the Annual Meeting of Delegates in accordance with the Texas Business Organizations Code and the Bylaws of the NBCE:

- that the NBCE acquire all, or substantially all, of the assets of the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards, a Wyoming nonprofit corporation (“FCLB”), as part of a combination of the NBCE with the FCLB whereby the NBCE and the FCLB will combine their organizations to provide the products and services previously separately provided by each organization so that in the future those products and services are provided collectively by one legal entity (the “Strategic Combination”);
- that to effect the Strategic Combination, the NBCE will enter into an Asset Purchase Agreement with the FCLB and other documents and agreements contemplated thereby providing for the purchase of FCLB’s assets by the NBCE; and
- that in connection with the Strategic Combination, the NBCE shall amend and restate its Bylaws to align with the Strategic Combination of the NBCE and the FCLB.
